

Starting August 1, 2024, fees associated with event parking arrangements will increase.

As The University of Toledo campus is aware, visitors may purchase their own "C" daily permits for \$5.95 by registering their vehicle at ParkUToledo.com, ParkMobile or by paying a parking meter. That remains unchanged and can be utilized for individuals or small groups visiting campus (vehicles must be registered and paid prior to parking).

Parking for large events will need to be arranged with the ParkUToledo office - the event organizer will be responsible for the parking fees.

In an effort to make sure that students and faculty are displaced as little as possible, ParkUToledo suggests scheduling larger events during "off peak times," when possible.

Peak Times:

Monday-Thursday, 7AM-4PM

Off Peak Times:

- Monday-Thursday After 4PM
- Thursday After 4PM thru Monday at 7AM
- Days when classes aren't in session
- Global Days
- Summer Session

EVENT PARKING OPTIONS

- 1. **Departmental Permits -** Departments may purchase "A" departmental permits for their visitors in the department portal. If you do not have an active department portal, please email: info@parkutoledo.com. Once an active departmental portal is established, departments can purchase two types of permits.
 - Daily "A" Permits \$5.95
 - Annual "A" Permits for \$341.15 (valid August-August).
 - Department must email <u>info@parkutoledo.com</u> to purchase annual "A" permits.
 - A 10% discount is available if 10 or more annual permits are purchased at the same time.



2. Suspension of Ticketing - In this scenario, the event coordinator is requesting that we do not ticket for permit violations in the requested lot. It's up to the event coordinator to make sure all visitors park in the requested lot. If visitors park in a different lot they will be issued a citation if no other permit is purchased (via ParkMobile, Daily etc).

Prices below reflect suspension of four hours or more. For ticket suspension less than four hours, please deduct 20% from the total price.

3. Virtual Event Parking Registration - Departments will get a specialized link for their parking event for guests to register for daily "A" permits on their own. The event organizer will be sent a link to forward to guests where they can input their vehicle information.

Guest license plates must be entered correctly or they will be ticketed.

Permits purchased through virtual event registration will be \$5.95 per vehicle with a \$75 administrative fee charged to the event organizer. Email events@parkutoledo.com for more information.



4. Reserved Spaces - Event coordinators may request that we block off spaces to reserve them for individual guests. Spaces will be blocked off and a ParkUToledo employee will remove the cones/barriers upon guest arrival. To avoid receiving a citation, the visitors MUST park in the reserved spaces. Please add \$22/hour for labor (4 hour minimum) as well as a \$125 administrative fee per event.
